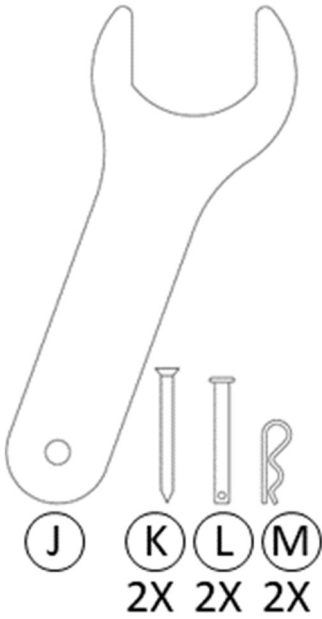

Compatibility: Not intended for use on angled ceilings, suspended ceiling. Compatible with bathtub wall thickness between 3" (7.62cm) and 7" (17.78cm). Waterproof.

Cleaning: Clean product with warm water and soap. Dry thoroughly before using.

Recycling: Product should be recycled in accordance with national guidelines.

Hardware / Tools



Compatibility:

Bathtub: The bathtub clamp for the Security Pole is compatible with standard Alcove bathtubs with flat sides and top. It is not compatible with curved tub walls. Tub wall thickness must be between 3" (7.62cm) and 7" (17.78cm).

Curtain Rod: The Security Pole may be incompatible or have limited compatibility with some fixed position curtain rods, due to interference. The Security Pole is compatible with all non-fixed curtain rods. It is recommended that non-fixed curtain rods be taken down prior to installation of the Security Pole and reinstalled, on the outside of the Security Pole and tub, afterwards.

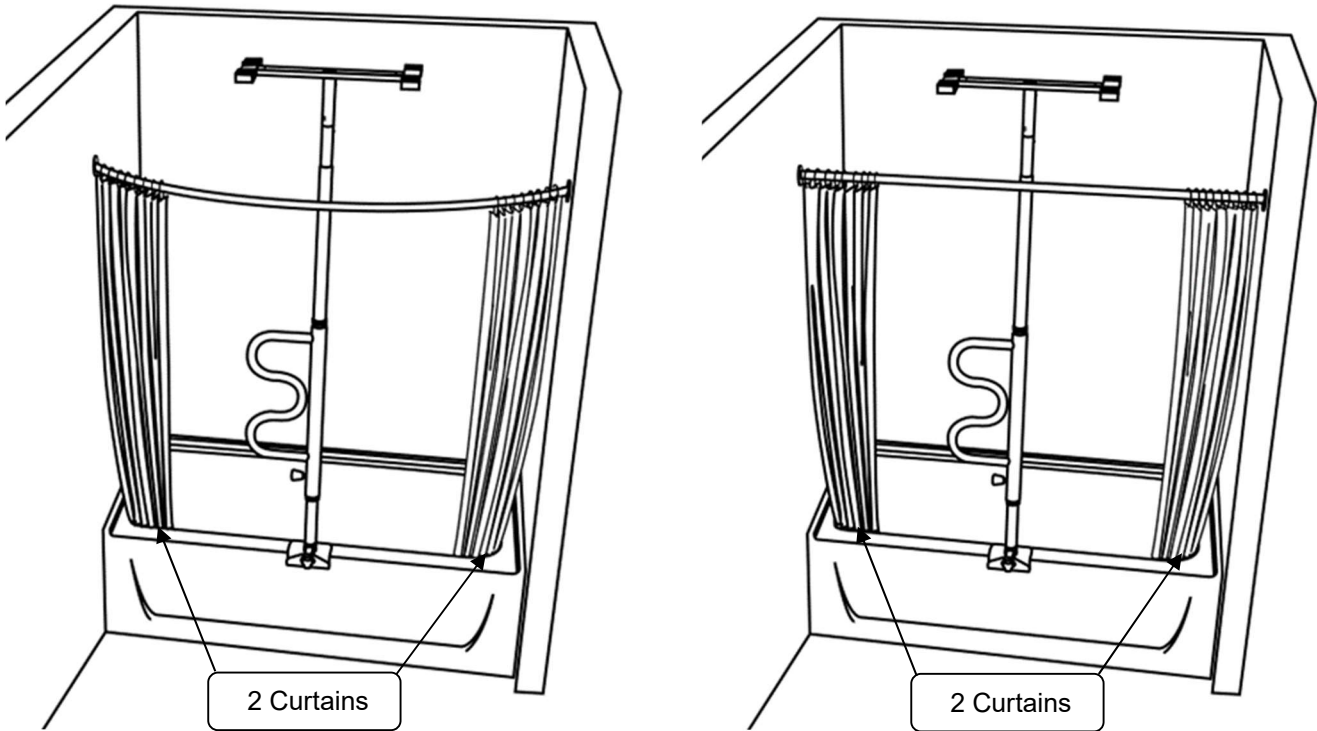
Shower Curtain: To ensure the water is contained within the tub, there must be a curtain on either side of the Security Pole. We recommend using a split curtain, or 2 curtains (one to each side of the pole) as shown below.

Ceiling: This Security Pole is not intended for use on angled ceilings. Ceiling must be flat and parallel to the floor.

Curved Curtain Rod

Straight Curtain Rod

Note: Both curved and straight curtain rods should be installed on the outside of the Security Pole, as shown below.



1. Remove the product from box/package. Remove black packaging component from **B**. Remove plastic sleeves **F** and **G** from **D**. Identify all parts as shown in *FIGURE 1*.

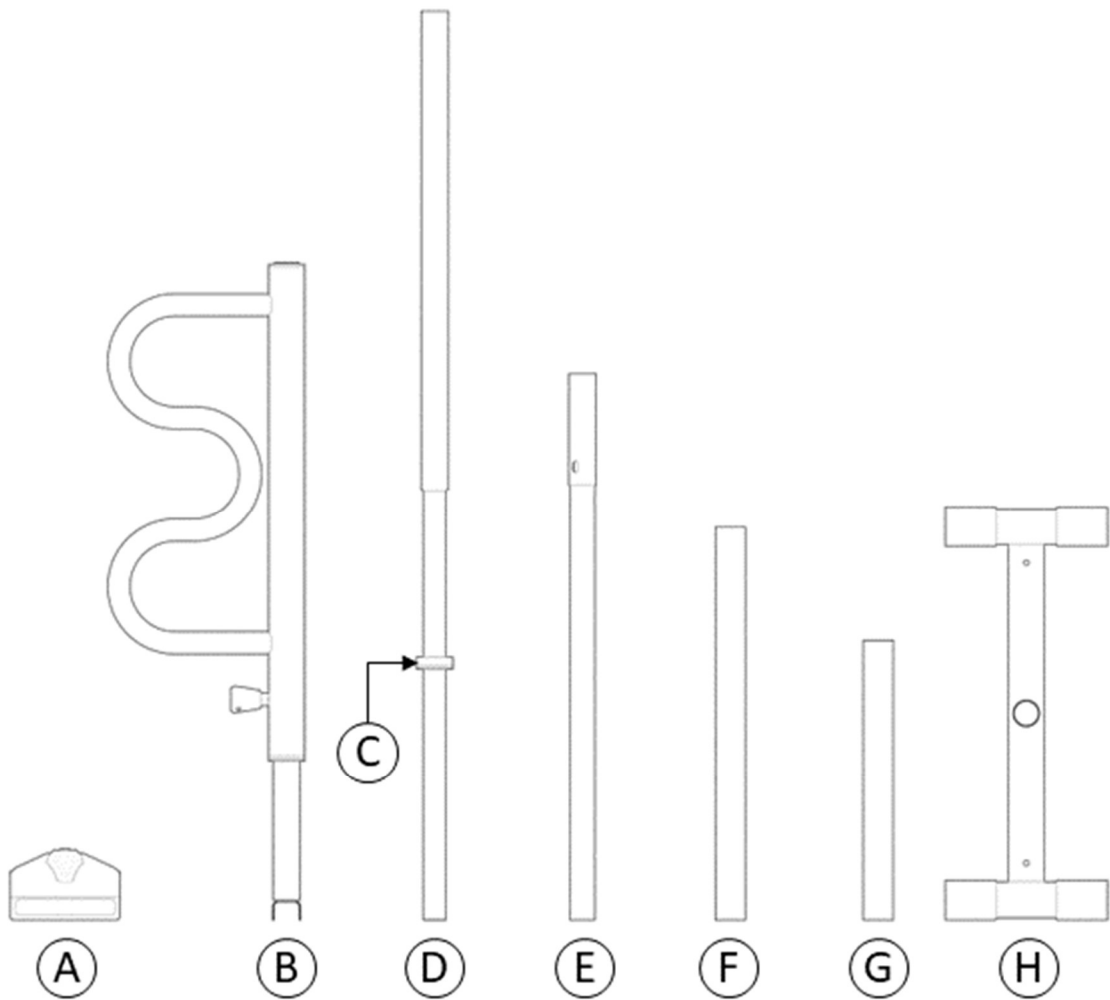

2. Determine the best location along the bathtub to mount **A**. See Options 1 & 2 below for recommended locations. **Note:** **A** must be mounted where the tub is flat both inside and outside as shown in *FIGURE 2*. The center of **A** must be at least 12in (30.5CM) from the wall to allow space for **H**.

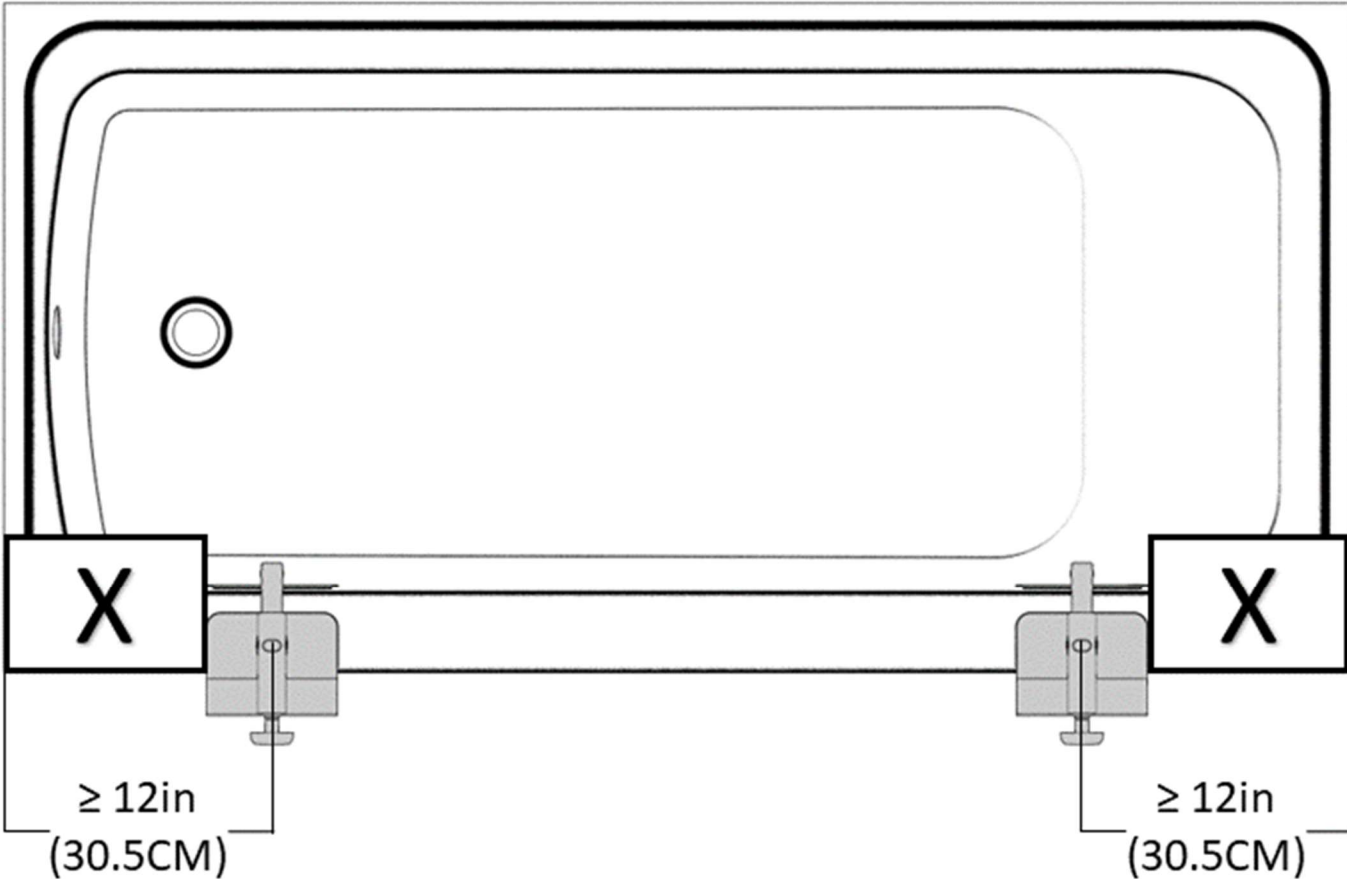
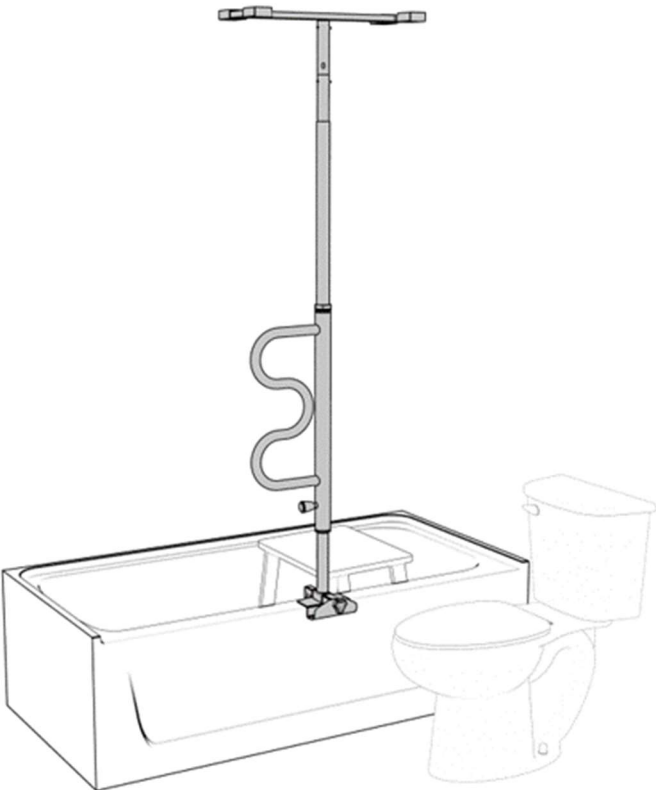

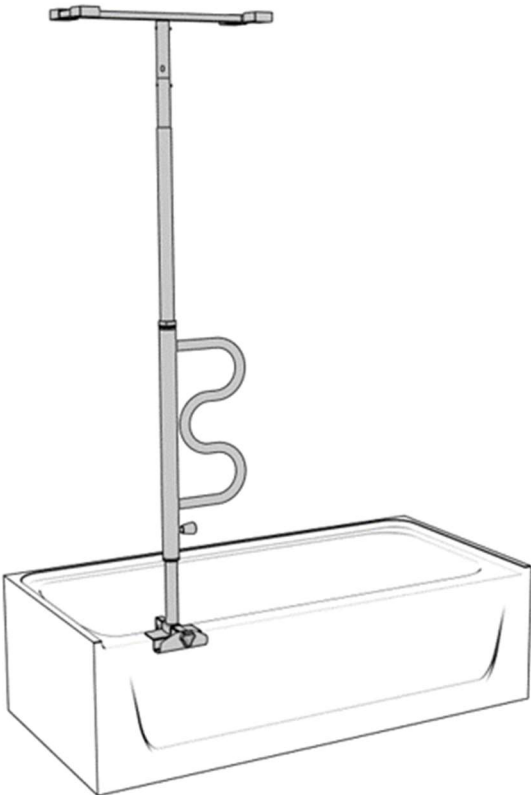
Recommendation 1

An ideal configuration is to mount the product in the center next to the toilet to allow the user to rotate the curve grab bar and use it as a bathtub grab bar and toilet grab bar in one.



Recommendation 2

Place the Security Pole near the front end of the bathtub to allow the user to use it while getting into/out of the tub and for support during a shower.



3. Ensure that the installation location is clean and dry prior to installation. Extend **A** to fit over the side of the bathtub, then rotate the knob clockwise to secure **A** to the tub as shown in *FIGURE 3*. Do NOT fully tighten.
4. Twist **C** to its highest position and insert **D** into **B** as shown in *FIGURE 4*. **Note:** If washers fall off, ensure that they are reinstalled prior to inserting **D** into **B**. Place the plastic washer directly under **C**, then place the metal washer under the plastic washer.

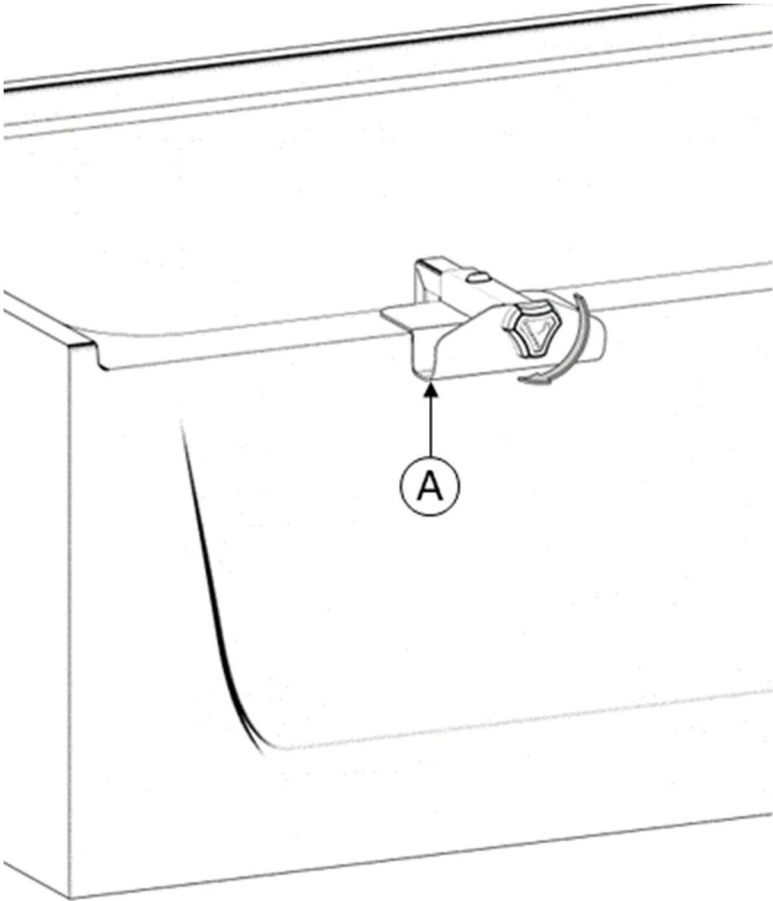

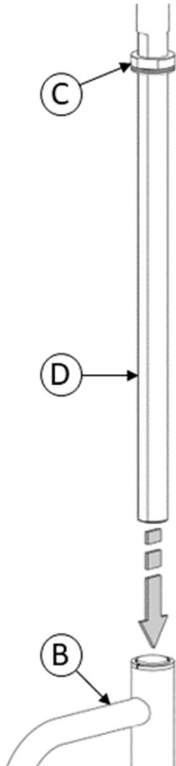

5. Determine the distance between the top of the bathtub and the ceiling. For distances less than 90" (2.3M), see Step 5-A. For distances greater than 90" (2.3M), see Step 5-B.

Step 5-A
For distances less than 90" (2.3M), install the longer plastic sleeve, **F**, over **D**.

Step 5-B
For distances greater than 90" (2.3M), install the shorter plastic sleeve, **G**, over **D**.

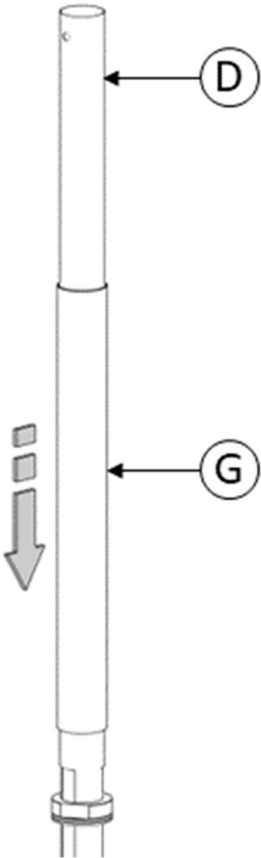
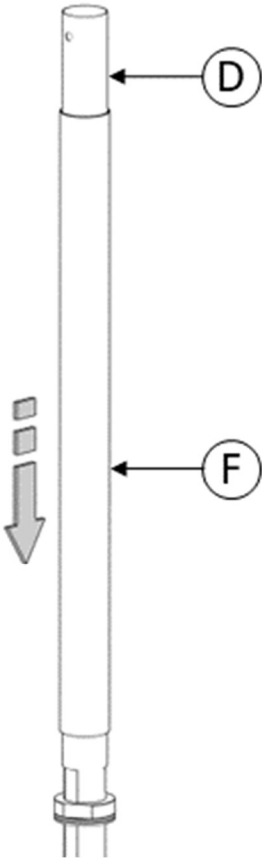

6. For bathtub to ceiling distances less than 80" (2M), align the upper adjustment hole in **E** with the hole in **D**. For distances between 80" (2M) and 90" (2.3M), align the center hole in **E** with the hole in **D**. For distances greater than 90" (2.3M), align the lower hole in **E** with the hole in **D**. Insert **L** through **D** and **E**. Insert **M** through **L** to secure as shown in *FIGURE 6*.

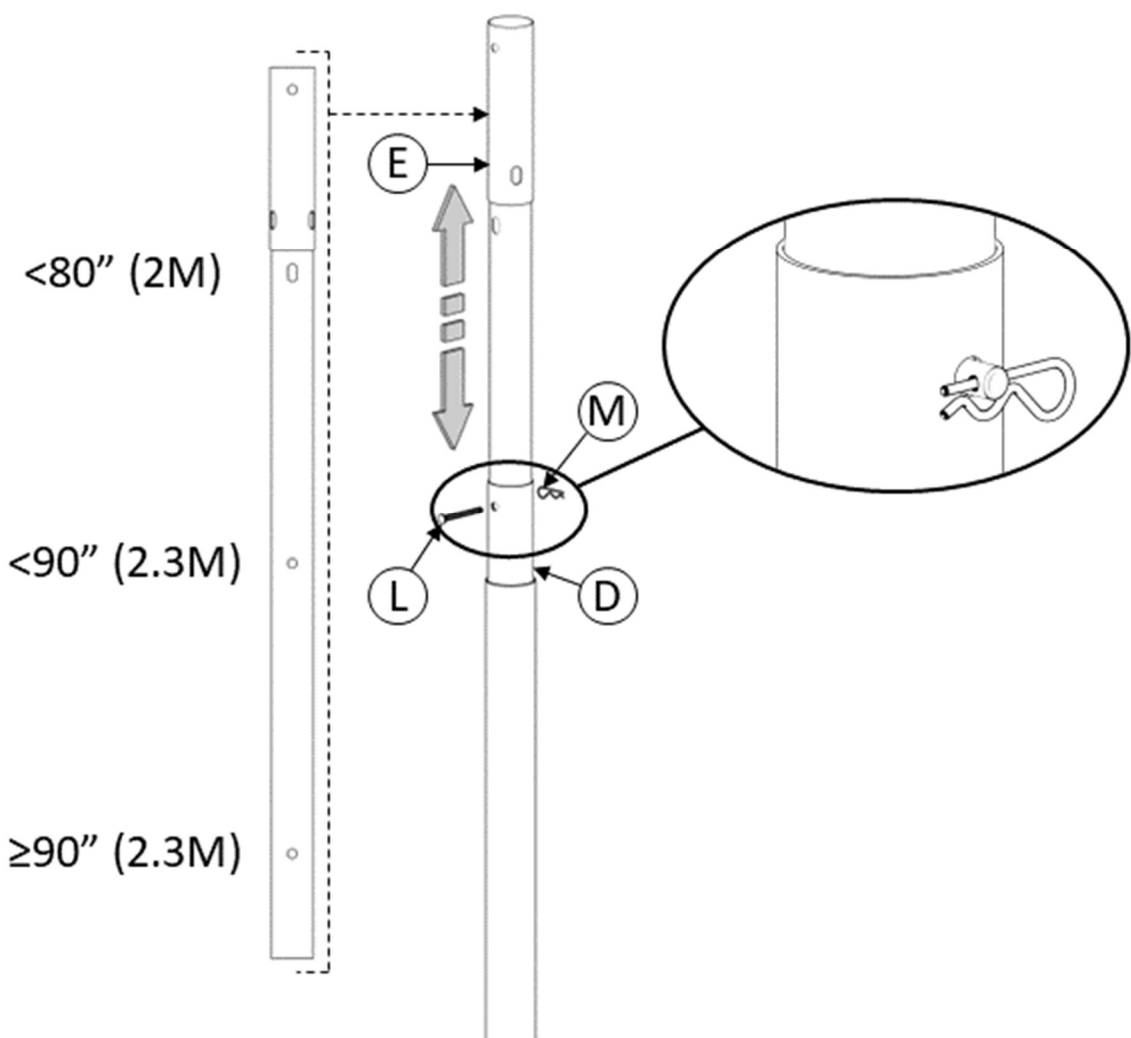

7. Install the remaining plastic sleeve, **F** or **G**, over **E** as shown in *FIGURE 7*. If **E** was connected to **D** using the upper adjustment hole, the remaining plastic sleeve is unused. **Note:** Plastic sleeve, **F** or **G**, should fully cover all visible metal on **E** while leaving the top hole accessible for the next step.

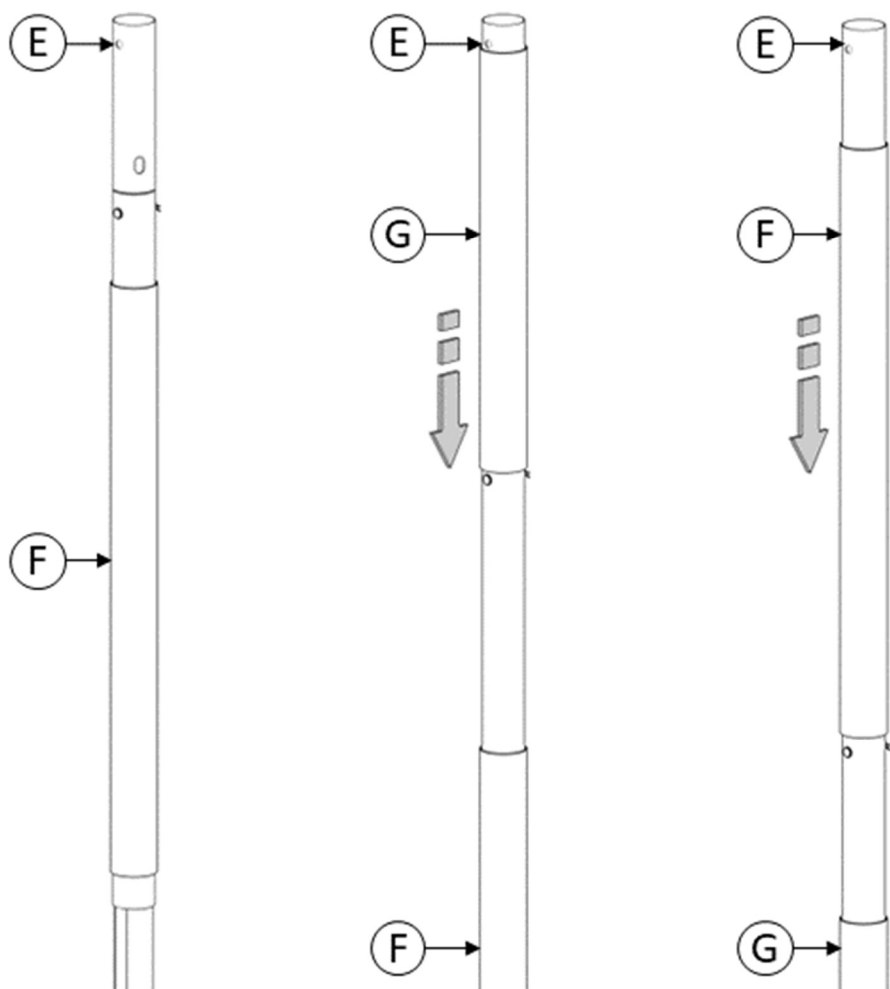

8. Insert **H** into **E**, align holes and insert **L** through **H** and **E**. Insert **M** through **L** to secure as shown in *FIGURE 8*.

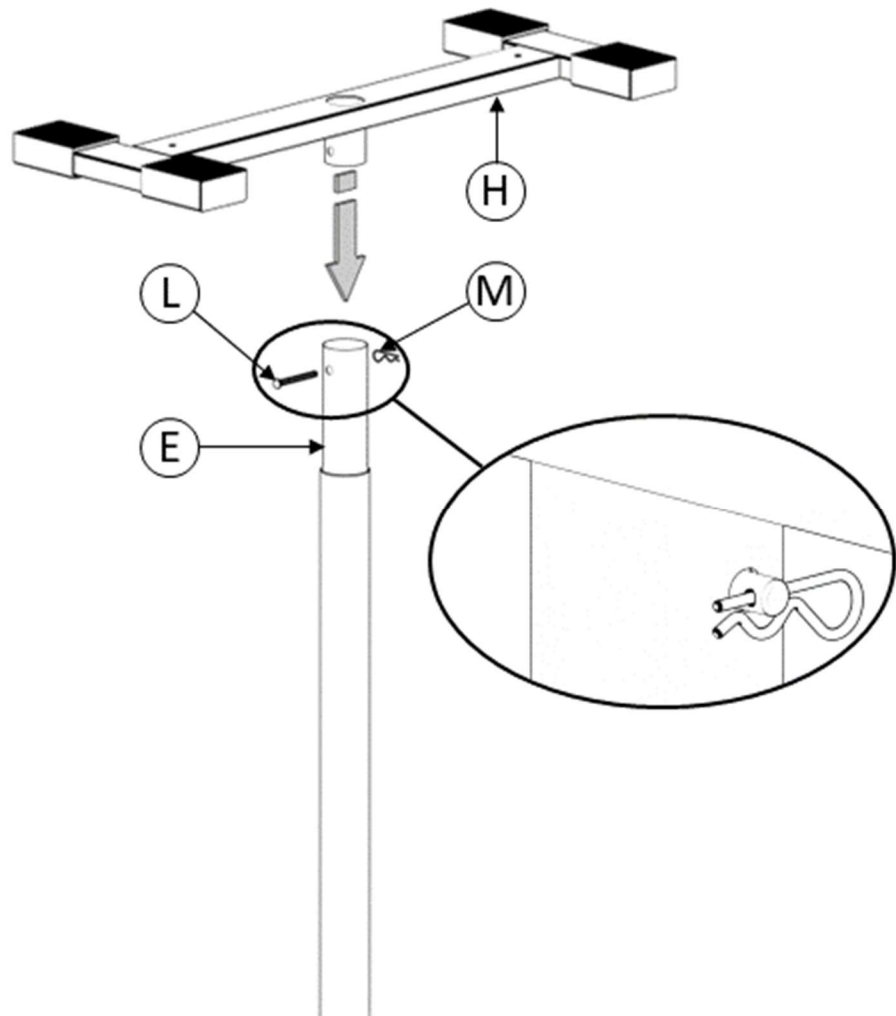

9. Insert **B** onto **A**. Ensure that the bump on **A**, aligns with the hole in **B** as shown in *FIGURE 9*. Cover red markings to ensure proper installation.

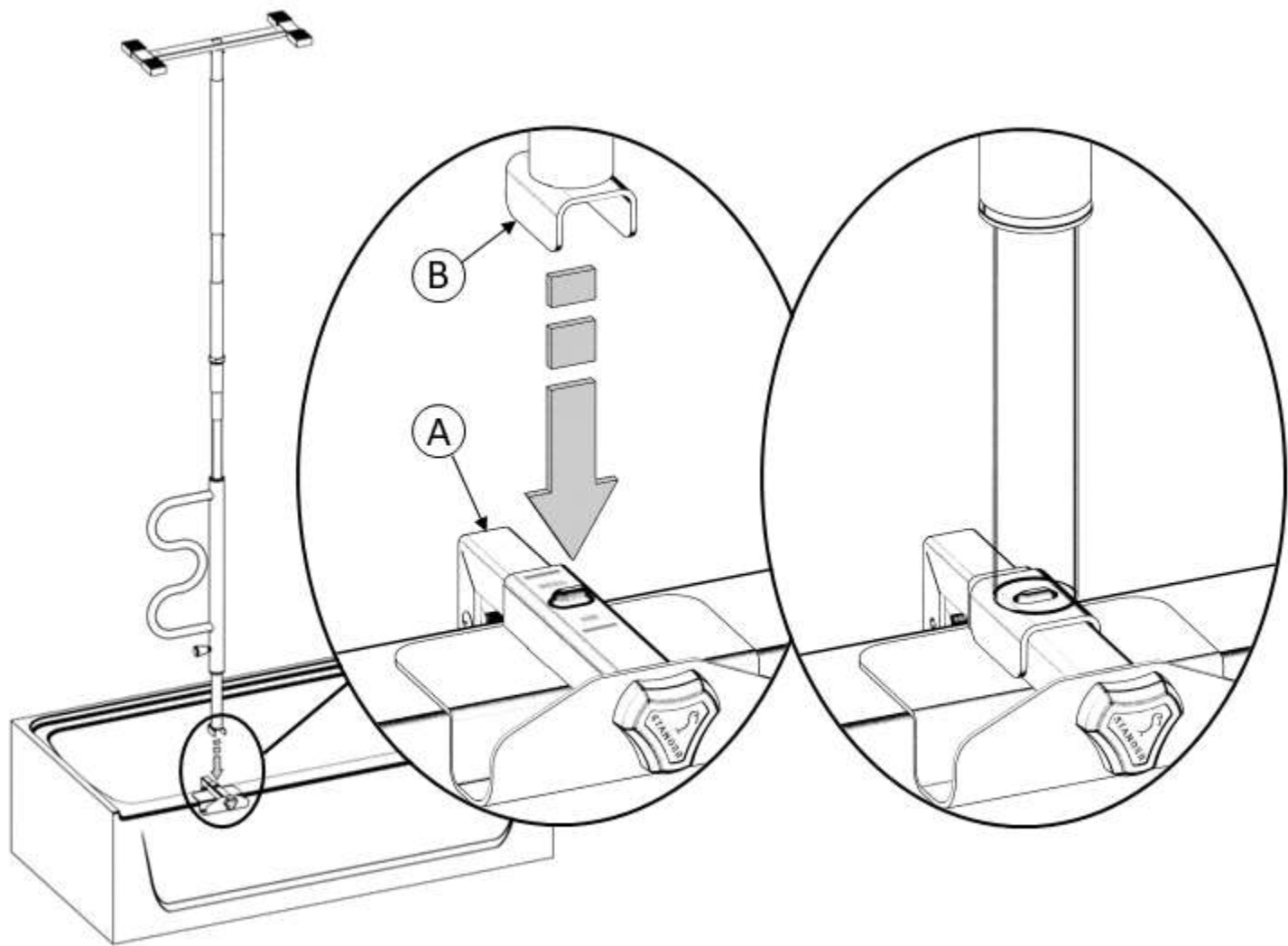

10. Ensure that the product is completely vertical (plumb). Tighten **C** using **J** as shown in *FIGURE 10*. Fully tighten **A**. Ensure the product is secured between the bathtub and the ceiling with ABSOLUTELY NO sliding of the product.

Caution: Do not overtighten as doing so may damage the bathtub, ceiling, or this product.

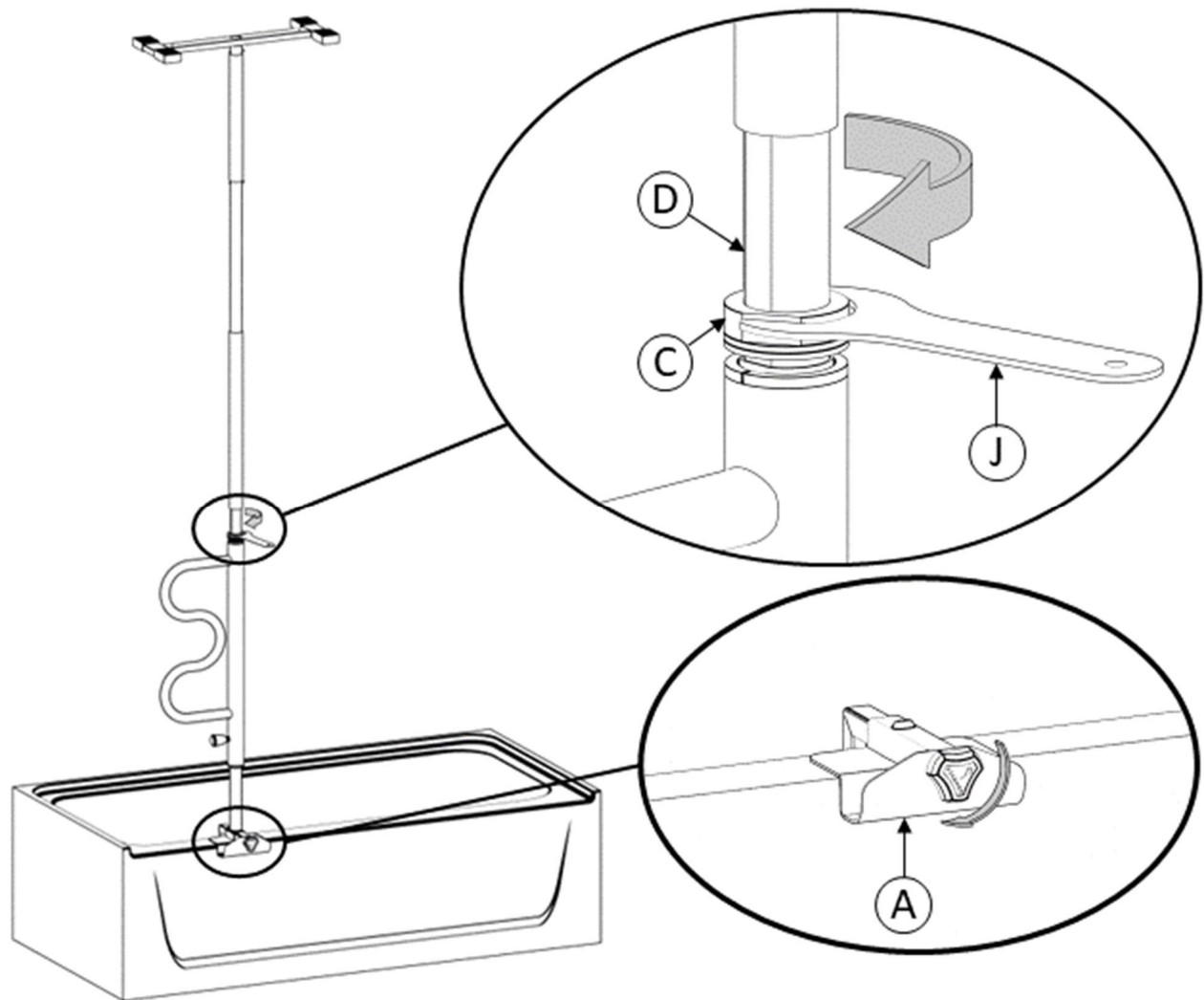

11. To rotate, pull the Spring Pin and rotate **B** to the desired location as shown in *FIGURE 11*. Release the spring pin and rotate **B** until the pin locks into place.

12. OPTIONAL: For additional security, use the provided screws, **K**, as shown in *FIGURE 12*, making sure that **K** goes into the Ceiling Joists.

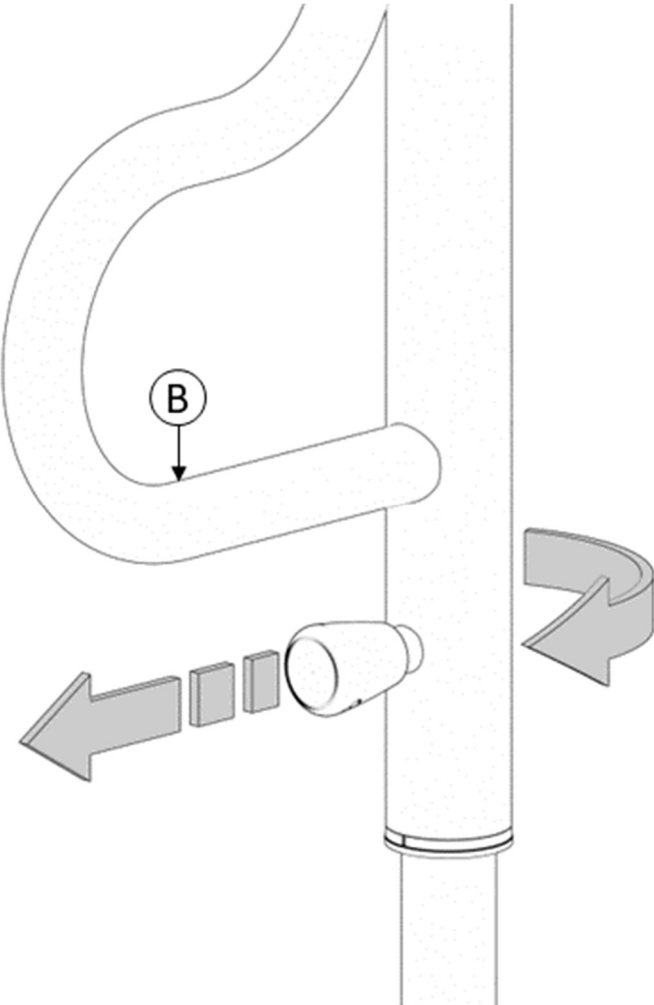

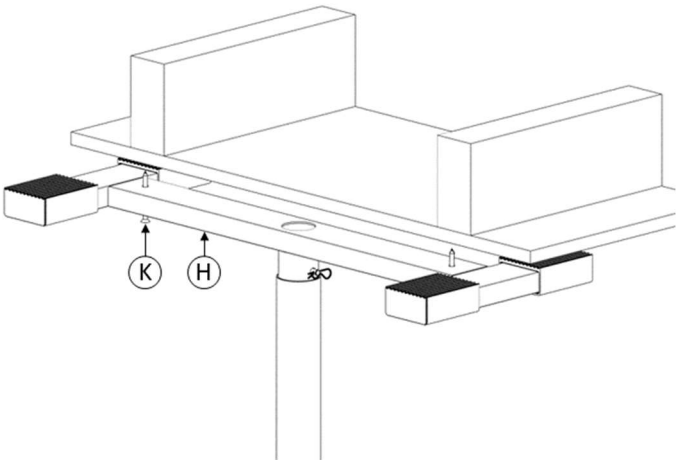
